Whether it was smoking in the rain or parking in mud, seniors offered suggestions for the improvement of the school in a December survey.

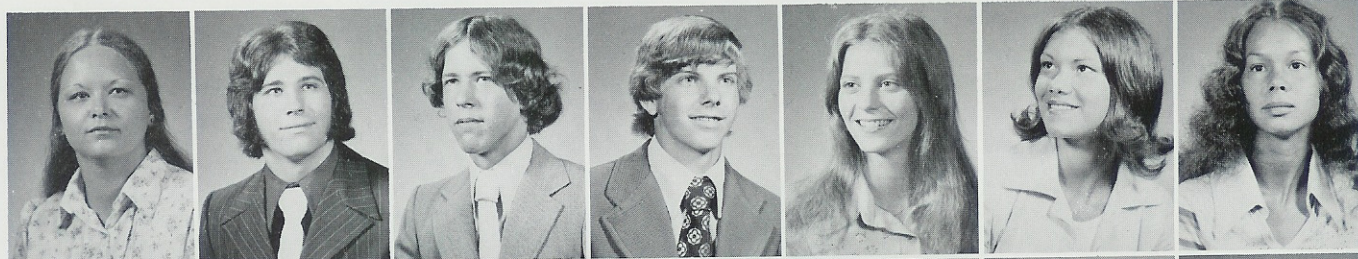
Some chose to laugh things off, save the furor over the parking lot. Other seniors criticized the narrow curriculum choices, while proposals for enriched courses kept popping up.
